NEWSLETTER – END OF TERM ONE 2020

As usual we would like to give you information on various issues;

- 1. Opening Date for the Cambridge and BTEC Learners** – All Cambridge and BTEC learners are expected to report to school to commence their Term Two program on **10th January 2021**. This means there will be no more online learning. They will now pay full school fees as per the invoices which will be sent along with the report cards.
- 2. Term One Reports** – Term One examinations have proceeded very well in the last two weeks and teachers are currently preparing the reports which we expect to post to your email addresses before the New Year. So we encourage you to read the reports in detail and advise your child/children appropriately. Where need be, get in touch with the relevant office(s) or subject teacher(s) to seek remedy.
- 3. The School No Cash Policy** – We, as before, wish to reinforce our no cash policy especially for those who have joined the school recently. All cash intended for the learners must be deposited with the school canteen. Let us all avoid leaving the children with any cash as this encourages other undesirable activities in the boarding area.
- 4. School Fees Balances** – Please ensure all school fees is paid on time and outstanding balances are cleared before or by the opening date. No learner with fees balances will be allowed in school.
